PROGRAMMING OPTIONS

- 1. EARLY MORNING DROP OFF:** 7:15 a.m. until 8 a.m. for families who need "before school care". Children will be supervised in a relaxed, free choice play environment, while teachers set up the classroom.

2. PRESCHOOL: 8 a.m. until 11 a.m. Monday through Friday. Please check the appropriate classroom and indicate your choice of days.

** Please note - Classroom placement for children turning three during spring and summer 2018 will be determined by the Preschool team with input from the family. Once Enrollment Forms have been collected, the Preschool team will review the Forms comparing ages, class make up, class size etc. in order to determine the best classroom fit to meet the needs of each child.

**If you are planning to have your child attend preschool for two years, enroll your child in the Bumble Bee class. If you are unsure when to send your child to 4K because of a late spring or summer birthday, please write that on this form.

Bumble Bees: Child must be at least 2 1/2 by September 1, 2018.

- Two days per week - Tuesday and Thursday
- Four days per week - Monday through Thursday
- Monday through Friday

OR

Dragonflies: Child must be at least 3 years old by September 1, 2018.

- Two days per week - Tuesday and Thursday
- Four days per week - Monday through Thursday
- Monday through Friday

3. LUNCH BUNCH - available 11 a.m. through 12:15 p.m., Monday through Friday. Children bring their own lunch. Unless child attends full days, child must be potty in order to participate in Lunch Bunch.

- Two days - Tuesday & Thursday
- Three days - Monday, Wednesday and Friday
- Four days - Monday through Thursday
- Monday through Friday

4. AFTERNOON SESSION - Monday through Thursday from 12:15 p.m. until 3:30 p.m., until 2:30 p.m. on Fridays. The Afternoon Class consists of a mixed age group. All children rest on a cot for a minimum of 30 minutes (as required by state licensing rules), have an afternoon snack, followed by free play.
